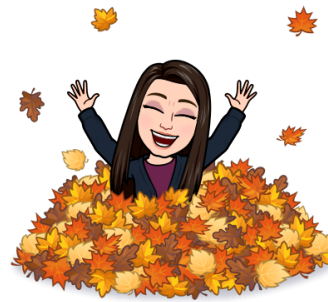

We are working through their handwriting practice booklet as it is an expectation for students in Grade 5 to write in cursive for all subjects. We are also doing Daily Language Reviews, which is a quick assignment in grammar and sentence writing.



We are preparing for Literature Circles, our Grade 5 reading program. We are reading through Holes by Louis Sachar as a class and are learning how to make connections with the text by relating the story to our personal experiences, to other media we have encountered, and to current or past world events.

Math

We are starting off the school year by reviewing Patterns and Relations. Throughout the year we will have an oral Math Fact Check-in to increase fluency and understanding of math facts. This will take place each week. This week's check-in will focus on the two times table.
