Memory work from Psalm 139 due on

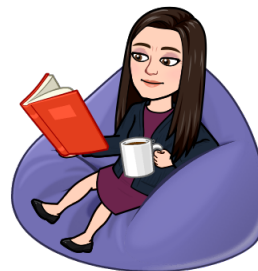
Thursday, February 10:
