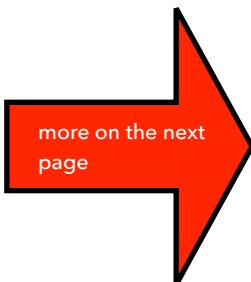

We are ready to begin our next section of Literature Circles! Our theme this term is: Mystery/Adventure. The students were presented with their options on Thursday and were given their novels today. After hearing a brief synopsis about each book, they made a "Top 3" list and were assigned one of their top choices. Essentially, students are able to read at their own pace and discuss the books in a group of students reading the same one. They are also required to complete journal entries detailing connections they are able to make with the stories or characters.
